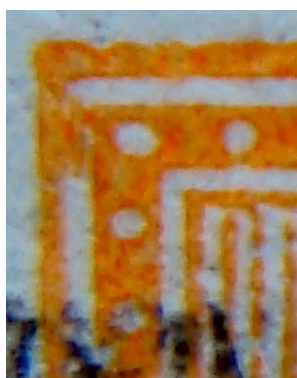
Varieties, errors and flaws a.o. on the bacis stamp

In Irish Philatelic Circle Journal March 1978 No. 1 T. S. Telfer, in June 1978 No. 2 M. H. Priestley and in June 2011 No. 2 John Lennon have published some very detailed articles of the **1941 Provisional Commemorative issue of the Ester Rising** - Hibernian 2020 Cat. No. C17 and C18.

My article only aims to show the varieties, errors and flaws on the Bacis Stamp I have collected over the years. I hope this inspires other to go hunting !.

Hibernian Handbook 2020 only mention varieties in the overprint.



No H1: Orange spot in frame in NW corner



No H1a: Orange spot over shamrock NW corner



No H2: Extended line over shamrock NW corner



No H3: Break in frame over ÉI in ÉIRE together with dot over g in Aiséirge joined



No H4: Orange notch in frame over shamrock in NW corner



No H5: Cut in inner frame NW corner



No H5a: White spot in shamrock NW



No H6: Broken inner circle in shamrock NW (three copies known)



No H7: Bullet in shamrock NW



No H7a: White line in shamrock NE



No H8: Bullet in shamrock NE



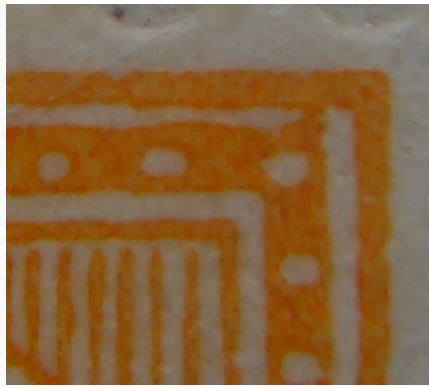
No H9: Thich corner frame NE
