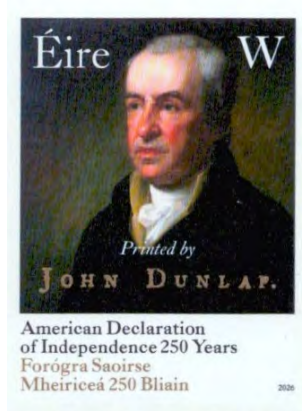
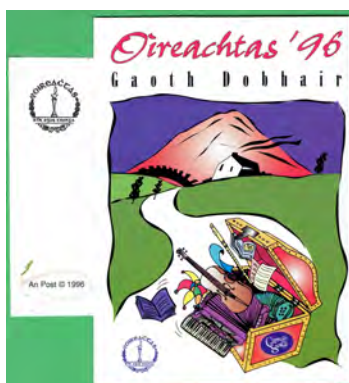

We have some very exciting Irish philatelic events coming up during the next 6 months.

- (a) Boston 2026: International stamp show at the Boston Convention Center May 23 to 30. An Post is sponsoring an ÉPA booth at the show and will provide several free souvenirs. JOHN DUNLAP, AN IRISHMAN FROM STRABANE, COUNTY TYRONE: PRINTER OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, JULY 4 1776

Some revolutionaries remain quiet, and behind the scenes, and one such gentleman was John Dunlap, an Irishman from Strabane, Ulster. Dunlap owned a print shop in Philadelphia and was tasked by Thomas Jefferson and John Hancock (1) to print 200 copies (or broadsides) of the American Declaration of Independence. The final version had been adopted by the Continental Congress on the morning of July 4, 1776 and the hand-written document was taken by Thomas Jefferson to Dunlap's print shop in the late afternoon (2). The printed copies were to be dispatched to the 13 Colonies, advising the 4 million American people that they were free from Great Britain and were about to form a new nation.

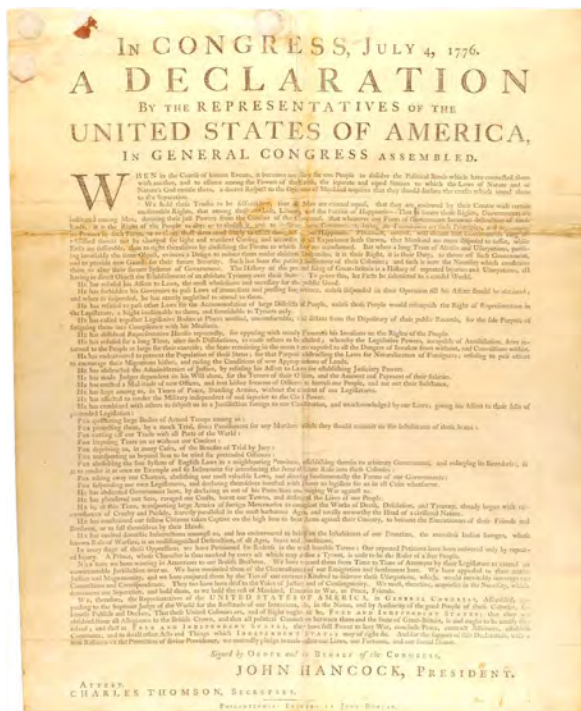


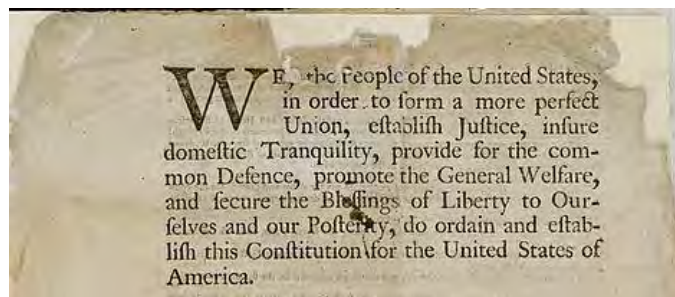
Figure 1: One of the surviving copies (Broadside) of the Declaration of Independence printed by John Dunlap on July 4 1776.

John Dunlap had secured a printing contract with Congress earlier in the year and he and his assistants worked throughout a hot and humid July night to print 150 to 200 copies or broadsides, some on paper with the watermark of King George III. The job had to be rushed and several copies were printed off-center and folded while wet leaving offset impressions (Figure 1).

John Dunlap was born in August 1746 in Strabane, Co. Tyrone. His grandparents were Scottish Presbyterians who moved to Ulster to escape religious persecution in the early 1700s. To avoid being pressed into service with the Royal Navy, Dunlap, at age 10, was sent to live with his Uncle, William Dunlap, in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. William Dunlap was a printer who moved his business to Philadelphia and John became an apprentice to his Uncle (3). John took over the business in 1766 and bought-out the business by 1770.

During the American War of Independence, Dunlap became a junior officer in the First Troop Philadelphia City Cavalry, also known as the Philadelphia Light Horse (formed in 1774). He saw action with George Washington at the battles of Trenton and Princeton. The Troop often acted as Washington's body guard during the war. Dunlap continued with the First City Troop after the war, rising to the rank of Major. He joined with Washington again in 1794 commanding Pennsylvania's cavalry militia to help put down the Whiskey Rebellion (4).

John Dunlap started and printed several newspapers, but the *North American and United States Gazette* in 1784 was reported to be the first successful daily newspaper in Philadelphia. Dunlap's government contracts continued after the war. Along with partner David Claypoole, they printed the *Constitution of the United States* on September 19, 1787 for the Constitutional Convention. The convention, sitting in Philadelphia, was tasked with trying to form "A More Perfect Union" (Figure 2).

Dunlap was also a successful businessman, buying land and property in Philadelphia, confiscated from Loyalists (5), as well as land in the territory of Kentucky, after the war. Dunlap retired in 1795 at age 48 and passed away in Philadelphia in November 1812. He never returned to Ireland.

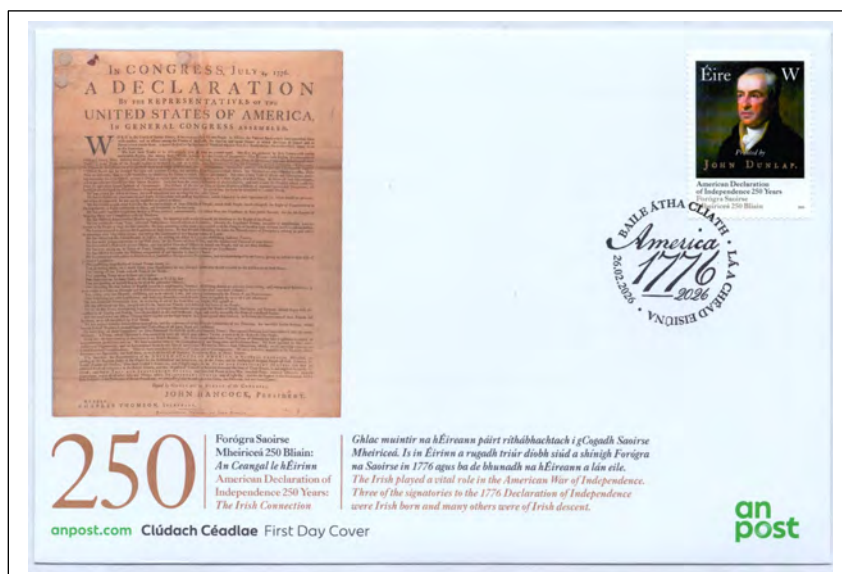


Figure 3: An Post official first day cover for the United States semiquincentennial featuring John Dunlap

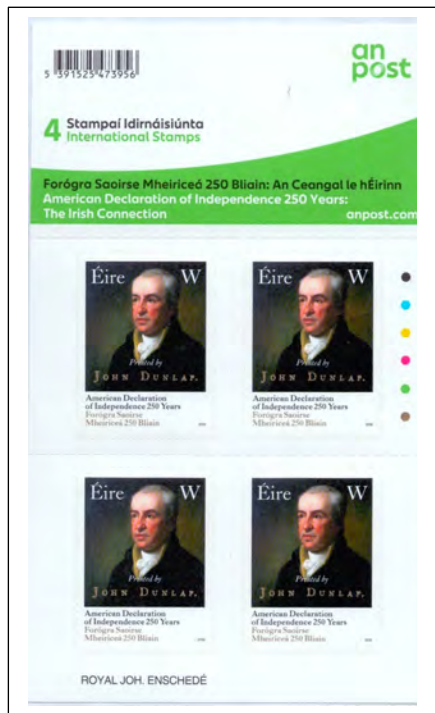
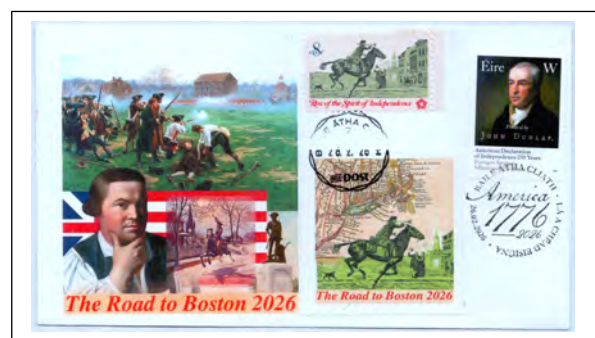
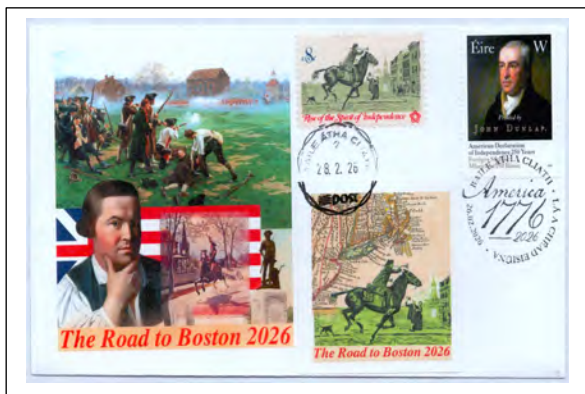


Figure 4: Sheetlet of four stamps featuring John Dunlap

An Post issued a stamp commemorating John Dunlap on February 26, 2026, in time for the stamp to be presented to President Trump by the Taoiseach, Micheal Martin, during the annual Irish delegation meeting at the White House (6). The stamp shows a portrait of Dunlap painted by Rembrandt Peal and is found in the *Museum of the First Troop Philadelphia City Calvary* (Figure 3). The Stamp was printed with a W value paying the International, Non-European rate in a self-adhesive sheetlet of 4 (Figure 4)

Notes

- (1) John Hancock is considered one of the *Founding Fathers of the United States*. He was the longest serving president of the Continental Congress and he was the first Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. His large and stylish signature on the *United States Declaration of Independence* has led his name becoming a colloquialism for a person's prominent signature. Thomas Jefferson was from Virginia and was also an American *Founding Father* and the third President of the United States. He was the principal author of the *Declaration of Independence*, along with Benjamin Franklin and John Adams.

- (4) The **Whiskey Rebellion** was a violent tax protest by farmers in the United States from 1791 to 1794 during the Presidency of George Washington. The "*whiskey tax*" was the first tax imposed on a domestic product by the newly formed federal government. The tax became law in 1791, and was intended to generate revenue to pay the war debt incurred during the American Revolutionary War. Farmers of western Pennsylvania and New York were accustomed to distilling their surplus rye grain mixtures to make whiskey. These farmers resisted the tax. Washington led an army in 1794 to put down the insurgency. 13,000 militiamen were provided by the Governors of Virginia, Maryland, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. The leaders of the rebellion fled before the arrival of the army, and there was no confrontation. About 150 men were arrested, and 20 were held for trial in Philadelphia, and only two were convicted (eventually pardoned). The Whiskey Rebellion demonstrated that the new American government had the ability to suppress violent resistance to its laws. However, the innovative farmers responded by exporting their whiskey and other products through the ports of British Canada.
- (5) **Loyalists** (also known as **Tories**, or **King's Men**) were colonists in the Thirteen Colonies who remained loyal to Great Britain during the American Revolution. The term was initially coined in 1774 when political tensions were rising, leading up to the outbreak of the war. Loyalists were required in 1776 to swear allegiance to the the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the United States. The penalty was forfeiture of property. The *American War of Independence* was both a global conflict and a civil war. Families and communities were often divided during the conflict, particularly in the southern colonies. After the war some 50,000 Loyalists fled the United States for British Canada and the British Caribbean.

BRIAN WARREN

Brian Mario Warren

Born: 1953

Died: Wednesday, 22

October 2025

Brian was born in Dublin in 1953. His father was Irish and his mother Italian. Only a few people know that his middle name was Mario. Brian was married to Maura for 45 years and was surrounded by lovely women throughout his life: his mother, his wife Maura and his two daughters Siobhan and Louise. He was a chartered accountant for his career.

I had known him since around 1984/85, when I first attended STAMPA, and at that time I also met his lovely wife and his daughters. He already joined FAI in 1987 and was given membership number 22987. In the same year, he began to publish his series of reports with the heading “That Was The Year That Was” (TWTYTW) in the December issue 1987 of our FAI-magazine DIE HARFE No. 25, during that time still under the German title “Das war das vergangene Jahr”. Until his last report in DIE HARFE No. 166 in the summer of 2025, he had written over 80 reports on the “New Issues of the Irish Post.” No other author of DIE HARFE has written so many reports, articles, etc. At this point we would also like to take the opportunity to thank Harald Lützenkirchen, who promptly delivered all German translations from day one.

Brian was always very friendly, open-minded and helpful. Although correspondence with him was conducted in English only, he did know a few words of German. On 25 March 1995, Brian was awarded the FAI Prize for his services to FAI, becoming the second Irish FAI member to receive this award after Bill Kane, who received it in 1986.

Richard Lütticken also has only good things to say about him, even though he only met him at STAMPA, where he followed the proceedings from “behind his large glasses.” It was always a good feeling for Richard to know that he had Brian’s “Recent Releases” (TWTYTW) in reserve when the current issue of DIE HARFE threatened to be too thin. His two-volume summary of Irish Philately (Compendium) from 1971 to 2020, comprising almost 1,000 pages, includes and describes more than all other catalogues about Irish Philately from that period

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put together. Brian Harmon described his great passion for Irish philately as follows: Brian Warren was the glue that held Irish Philately together, not only in Ireland.”

For many years, Brian Warren was also Chairman and Treasurer of STAMPA, for which he toiled tirelessly until his very last second. His services to this organization are unique, and the special STAMPA souvenirs would be inconceivable without his creative ideas. I would like to mention here his excellent and successful collaboration with the Irish Post Office. This also applies to the vending machine stamps of recent years, which – with a STAMPA overprint from 2022 onwards – were only printed in mini editions.

I would also like to mention the great reference work that Brian Warren generated in arduous detail together with Joachim Schaaf (FAI publication series volume 31), It is entitled “Irish Postage Rates – 1839 to 2014” and has become a bestseller and a sought-after brochure worldwide for all Ireland Collectors interested in postage rates.

His specialized collections on the various definitive series, displayed with unique knowledge, were awarded permanently with Gold or Large Gold in many exhibitions.

He must also have had many reliable sources of information for this accumulated knowledge. One could get the impression that he had good connections to every post office in Ireland to find special or unusual items, documents or stamps even information about those what were not yet known.

Now the king of our hobby has suddenly passed away, leaving a huge gap that will be very difficult to fill.

We remember him - RIP Brian Warren.

IRISH CONNECTED AIR COVERS, 1925-1934

The first successful flight covers to Ireland listed by William J. Murphy in his seminal work, **Irish Airmail; 1919-1990**, are the ones flown by Alcock and Brown in the first successful flight across the Atlantic Ocean from St. John's Newfoundland to Clifden, Ireland, on June 14/15, 1919. The landing in Ireland was not planned, and the bog that appeared safe to land caused the airplane to sink into the field and eventually flip over.

Since 1919 many hundreds of inaugural flights have occurred initiating regular flights to and from Ireland. Additionally, Murphy mentions, "Acceptance flights", that is letters or other postal items sent from Ireland, North or South, to be carried on a flight originating in another country, and not necessarily coming back directly to Ireland.

I have selected 8 covers, from the period 1925-1934, to illustrate this interesting aspect of collecting Irish related material. Some of the later flights, particularly the Pan American (Pan Am) and Trans World (TWA) airlines flights, carried large quantities of postal material that are often seen in the philatelic arena. The Amelia Earhart solo flight of May 20/21, 1932, carried only 50 covers that were all signed by Miss Earhart; such an item that would make a wonderful addition to anyone's personal collection. Unfortunately, I do not have such a cover in my collection.

1. *Cairo to Baghdad; Posted from Dublin, Nov. 12, 1925*



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This cover was prepared by John S. Davis, a dealer from Liverpool. There are no receiving marks on the back of the envelope. The flight would have been undertaken by the newly organized Imperial Airways. The British government encouraged four British companies to reorganize into a workable group and hoped to expand air routes eventually all the way to Australia.

2. *Liverpool to Belfast; Posted from Liverpool, Sept.22, 1928 with Belfast date 2 days later*



A registration fee was paid for this cover for a total fee of 5 ½ pence. The registration receiving mark, on the back of cover, is from Belfast, September 24, 1928. The flying-boat Calcutta, left

Liverpool at 10:00 a.m. for Belfast, and returned from Belfast on the same day at 4:45 p.m. This experimental program ended October 4, 1928.

3. *London to Karachi; Posted from Dublin, March 28, 1929*



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This cover has an April 6, 1929 date stamp on the back of Karachi, British India. Another imprint on the back of the cover, BCM/AIR FIELD may indicate this is another cover from John S. Davis. This flight is another from Imperial Airways and with 8 pence of British stamps overprinted for use in Ireland makes for an interesting item.

4. *Galway to London; Posted from Galway with red oval cachet dated 26 Aug. 1929*

This is my first cover with a stamped or printed cachet; this makes it much easier to determine the specific flight indicated. Murphy lists 11 possible covers with various postal marks for this experimental



flight. The Krag machine slogan cancel from Galway, Buy Irish Goods, was first used in July of 1926. This cover was addressed to John Davis and with the Poste Restante reference, was to be returned to Galway on the return flight. As in many cases, this experimental flight did not result in a regular air mail service between these two cities.



5. *London to Cape Town; Posted from Dublin, arrived in Cape Town, Feb 2, 1932*

This illustrated cover, another from John Davis, indicates it to be the first regular flight from London to Cape Town via Imperial

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Airways. 1 Shilling and 8 pence postage come from the first definitive series of Ireland. The cover was posted on January 19, 1932, and appears to have taken two weeks to reach its destination.

6. *Galway to Berlin; Posted from Galway and arrived the same day, 22 Oct. 1932*



Another experimental flight which did not develop into a regular service. The flight left Galway, stopped in Dublin, then Croydon and Rotterdam for refueling, and then on to Berlin, arriving at 5:30 p.m., German time on the same day. A few covers from this flight travelled on the 9th Graff Zeppelin flight to South America. An advertised postal rate of 6 pence was announced, and this cover has the correct postage to Germany.



7. *Dun Laoghaire (Kingstown, Dublin) to Singapore; Posted on board ferry to Singapore 1933*

This interesting illustrated cover seems to have been posted on board a ferryboat from Ireland to, most

likely, Wales. This Imperial Airways flight from London to Singapore, arrived December 19, 1933. The captain of the flight indicates this cover was to be flown on the first return flight from Singapore to London. The cover is dated and signed on the back by the captain on January 11, 1934. There is a receiving stamped date and town, appears to be Lee-on-Solent in England. My only Paquebot, Posted on the High Seas, airmail first flight.

8. *Bristol to Belfast; Posted August 10, 1934*

The final cover presented is one of 18 possible flights, to and from Belfast, organized by the British Post Office to initiate Railway Air Service throughout the United Kingdom. This route was to begin November 20, 1934, but had difficulties in many of the proposed routes. The data seems to show that



this was not a great success. The cover shown originates from Bristol but does not seem to have been flown to Belfast. The last day of air mail service by the Railway Air Service to Belfast was November 30, 1934.

What is here presented is but a sample of the very interesting history of airmail service from and to Ireland over the years. With today's internet dominating all forms of communication, it is sobering to visit the past and learn how all forms of communication have adapted and changed, not always for the better, so hopefully we continue forward with caution, but always with hope.

Good evening, everyone,

*First, thank you so much to **Mr. Logue and the Burlington County St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee** for bestowing this incredible honor on me. To be named **Ms. St. Patrick of Burlington County** is something I never imagined, and I am deeply grateful—not just for the title, but for what it represents: a celebration of Irish culture, history, and community.*

*I would also like to thank **Miss Sara**, my Irish Dance Teacher, who nominated me for this opportunity and who has shaped such a big part of my life through Irish dance (Figure 3). Irish dance is so much more than steps and music—it tells the story of a people. It tells that story in the rhythm of the music, in the patterns of the steps, and even in how we hold our bodies with pride and strength. Miss Sara has taught me with*

incredible patience and professionalism, and she has shown me that discipline and joy can exist together. Because of her, dance is not just something I do — it is a way I connect to my heritage.

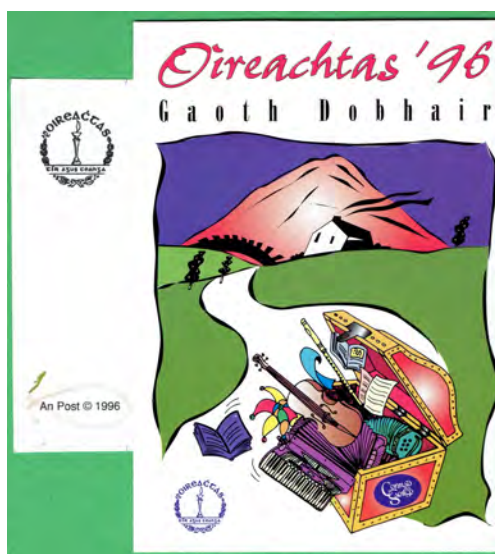


Figure 5: Card from the Irish Folk Fair, *Oireachtas*. Note the printing source on the reverse side.

*I also want to thank my **grandfather**, who gave me the gift of storytelling. He taught me how history isn't just something you read—it's something you tell. Through him, I learned how to take stamps and other philatelic materials and weave them into a story. From those lessons came my two-frame, international award-winning stamp exhibit, **The Life and Celebrations of Saint Patrick** (Figure 4). And even more importantly, my love of storytelling has given me the courage to write my book, **The Children who became St. Patrick (1)** (Figure 5). This historical novel explores Patrick's lesser known time as a boy and as a slave in Ireland; and his sister Dareca, who accompanied Patrick on his travels. Storytelling, I've learned, isn't just about the past—it's about making sure the past still has a voice.*

*I want to thank my **grandmother** for giving me the gift of family. Because of her, I've had the incredible opportunity to travel all over Ireland, visiting aunts and cousins, and experiencing this hauntingly beautiful island firsthand. Ireland isn't just a place on a map to me—it's faces, voices, kitchens full of laughter, stories told at tables, and roads that always seem to lead somewhere older than memory. Those trips didn't just teach me geography—they taught me a belonging.*

*I also want to thank my **father** for his hard work and dedication in providing all of these opportunities. His work ethic is quiet, steady, and constant. It's often overshadowed but never overlooked. Everything I've been able to do—travel, study, dance, write—stands on the foundation of his effort and sacrifice, and I am so grateful for that.*

*And finally, I want to thank my **mother**. She has taught me to think outside the box—to understand that learning and writing don't have to be linear, and that sometimes the best ideas come from the messiest drafts. She is my teacher, my editor, my confidant, and—very often—my referee. I have three siblings, and we are homeschooled, so there is a lot of refereeing in my house. But through all of it, she has shown me what it means to believe in your children and to help them become who they are meant to be.*

Being Irish, to me, begins with storytelling. It lives in music, in dance, in history, and in the way we remember who we are—even after centuries of hardship. The Irish people have faced famine, loss, exile, and struggle, yet somehow, they never lose their humor, warmth, or ability to welcome others. That's something worth celebrating—and something worth carrying forward.

*So today, I want to challenge all of us to **live, laugh, and love** the way the Irish have done for a millennium —despite hardship, despite loss, and sometimes even because of it.*

And I'd like to leave you with one of my favorite Irish blessings:

*May the road rise to meet you,
May the wind always be at your back,
May the sun shine warm upon your face,
And the rains fall soft upon your fields,
And until we meet again,
May God hold you in the palm of His hand.*

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AN POST: COMMERCIAL PRINTER AND INFORMATION PROCESSOR

In 1922, when the Irish inherited the Post Office, they found they had an 1870 -era operation with totally manual operation, no automation, and deplorable working conditions. The Irish maintained this operation almost untouched until a major postal strike almost shut down the country in 1979. This situation was partially due to parliamentary interference and partially endemic under-funding; the solution was a private for-profit postal company that was owned but not controlled by the government. In 1984, *An Post* replaced the *Ministry of Post and Telegraphs*. The telephone and telegraph portion of the old post office was spun-off as a separate company. Thus, it was chartered to make a profit (or at least break even) without Parliamentary control or interference in its operations. The immediate result was an increase in postal rates and the closure of over 1,500 small and less used postal stations, much to the dismay of the unions and Parliament. It also meant that the post offices had to have items and services that modern society wanted and needed. Ferguson details these changes in his last chapter, while Jüng and Warren, et al, list many examples of postal cards and post cards.

For example, by 1984 there had been only eleven rate changes to postal card designs since 1922. [See Figures 1 and 2]. Postcards are in demand by tourists. None of these were of interest. An Post created

newer, modern postal cards in many designs, [see Figure 3] and expanded into the picture postcards commonly used by tourists. Companies that had been printing them complained that not only was An Post stealing their business, but under-pricing them. [See Figure 4] To their dismay, they learned that the competition was not the government, but another private company, and

competition was legal and appropriate. The new postcards and postal cards were sellouts.

An Post had made substantial investments in modern printing equipment. To run a modern postal operation requires an amazing amount of paperwork (although this has decreased with the expansion of computers). Nonetheless, forms remain needed for human interface and places where computers are not practical (shrinking rapidly but not yet completely). Modern printing equipment requires continual maintenance by highly skilled operators. Scheduling man-hours, periodic maintenance and variable factors such as unscheduled maintenance, and people is a constant juggling act. While interesting, that is not what customers want. They want results and modern materials.

Full utilization of available printing press time is vital to make money. In the first two years, 1984 to 1986, over 62 postcard designs were printed by An Post. The volume also increased to meet demand. Modern equipment and modern mind-sets combined to make operation more efficient. Other customers were attracted. [See Figure 5]

In 1994, An Post created a new subsidiary called PrintPost. They advertise document production, printing, and delivery along with additional services. Another subsidiary of An Post, Transaction Services (which is the part of the business that operates the postal service), also offers document creation for the real estate and other business sectors. Their web pages, (www.anpost.com/commerce) list what they can provide. Interface with the postal function is seamless, since it is a part of the same company. The national lottery is run by another subsidiary. What now exists as An Post is an integrated company, *An Post*, specializing in delivering information. After all, isn't that what a postal agency is supposed to do? If and how it is collected, if at all, is a different question.

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AN INTERESTING COVER – TARIFFS APPLIED TO PHILATELIC MATERIAL

Although not directly related, the following cover may be of interest, given the current uncertainty on application of tariffs by US Customs and Border Protection on philatelic material.

The scans below show a 1941 registered cover from Dublin to Canada with Map 1d (Hib. D17) and Arms 2½d (Hib D5, watermark se) tied with a Dublin code 2 “BAILE ATHA CLIATH 21 JA 41” cancel. The cover was detained and examined by Canadian customs and was determined to be duty free as indicated by the circular “NATIONAL REVENUE POSTAL BRANCH DUTY FREE Toronto Ont. Feb 25th 1941” circular cachet. Most likely the envelope contained philatelic material as it was mailed from the Philatelic section of the GPO. Note delivery to Canada (by surface mail) took over a month during war time. The cover is backstamped with Montreal, Toronto Section G and Toronto Registration Division cancels.



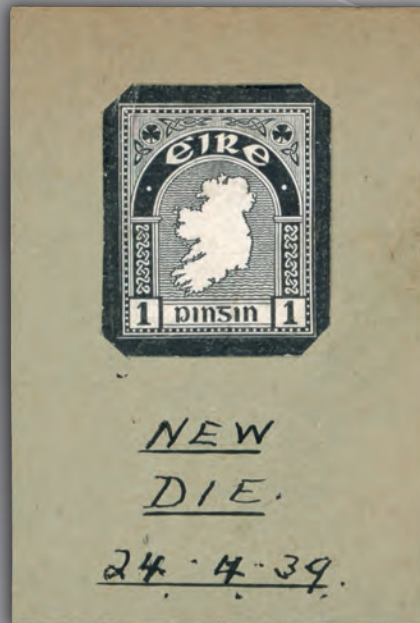
The envelope used is the old P&T SAORSTAT EIREANN printed type, with letters crossed through to make EIRE. This was most likely an effort to use whatever stationery material was available during wartime paper shortages.
