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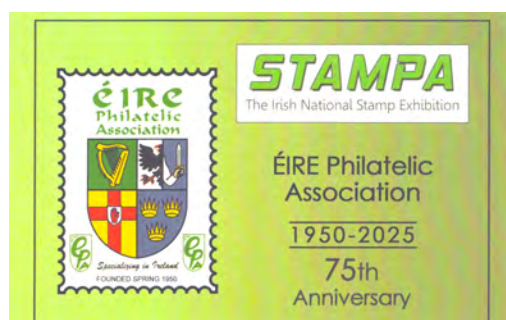

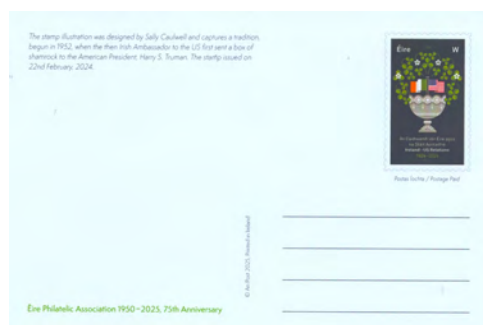

WEBMASTER'S REPORT — É P A WEBSITE

Over the past two years, the Éire Philatelic Association's website has faced persistent challenges with its hosting platform, WordPress. These issues—ranging from accessibility limitations to inconsistent performance—have affected the user experience for both members and visitors. Despite numerous attempts to resolve these problems through direct communication with WordPress support, the responses received were often vague and unhelpful, often through an AI bot. Recognizing the need for a more reliable and responsive solution, I consulted with an experienced webmaster, Lucy from **Mad Creative**, who was originally recommended during the initial development phase of our site. Lucy has since taken proactive steps to overhaul the website's infrastructure and interface. The cost for this service was around \$400.

I'm pleased to report that the site is now **fully accessible** to all users. This includes seamless access to key sections such as:

- Auction pages
- Archived issues of *The Revealer*
- General member resources

The improvements have already begun to enhance engagement and usability, and feedback from members has been encouraging.

Looking ahead, we plan to **reintroduce a secure sign-in section for paid members** in 2026. This will allow for personalized access to exclusive content and services, while maintaining the open accessibility of general resources.

In light of these updates and developments, the association will be formally **terminating its hosting arrangement with WordPress** and transition fully to **Mad Creative**. Lucy's team currently hosts the **Irish Philatelic Circle (IPC)** website and is actively updating the **STAMPA** website, demonstrating a strong track record in managing philatelic and cultural web platforms. Lucy has agreed to take over from WordPress as soon as the Word Press contract is terminated. We will be sending out a letter advising Word Press that we will no longer be requiring their services and to assist Mad Creative with the transition of all materials currently housed by Word Press.

This transition will ensure our digital presence remains modern, secure, and aligned with the needs of our members.

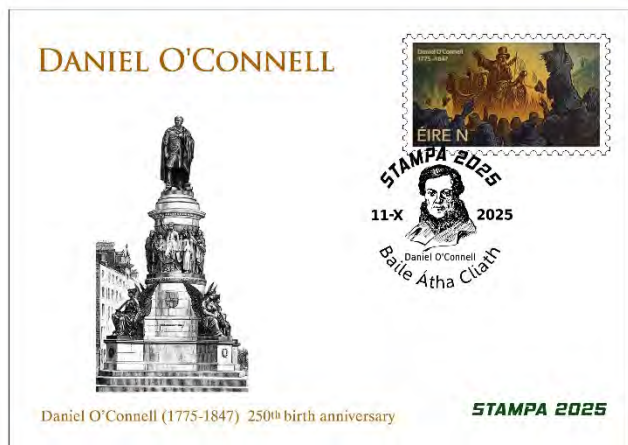
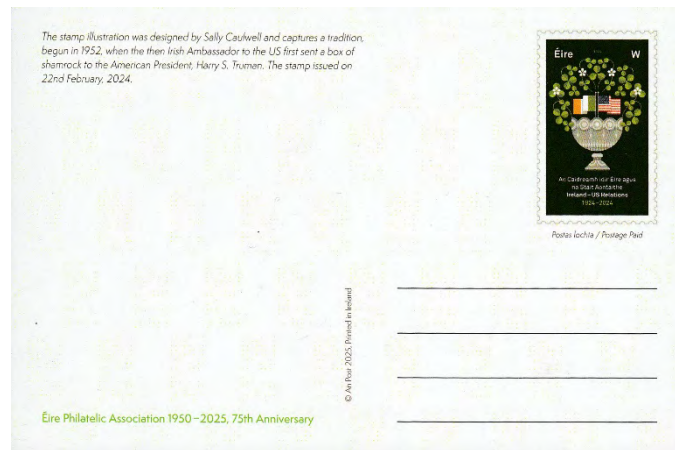

COULD THIS BE THE BOOKLET DISCOVERY OF THE CENTURY? OR NOT!

A Rare Variety of HB736-53 Willie Mackle

This is a short story of discovery. A time when you were not looking for it, but unexpectedly you notice you possess a philatelic object different from the others that you assumed shared the same cataloguenumber. What I discovered is not listed in any of the major catalogues. Booklets are a specialized corner of Irish Philately, particularly the earlier booklets containing definitive stamps. Roy Hamilton-Bowen's Hibernian catalogue, the Irish stamp bible, has an excellent section on booklets. In it he states "*Irish Stamp Booklets were first put on sale on August 21st, 1931.*" Most of the booklets produced prior to 1957 have advertisements on the front and back covers, as well as advertisements on interleaves between the panes of stamps and labels.



HB7a 36-53 plus ??

Recently, I won an auction lot that included a booklet listed as Hibernian catalog number HB7a 36-53. The edition number appears on the cover under the harp as seen in the illustration. This specific edition of HB7 was on sale from 1953 to 1960 for 2/6, and is by far the most common booklet issued prior to 1960. The condition of any early booklet is crucial to its value. So, when it arrived I determined that the condition was good and that all 4 stamp panes were included and intact. HB7a 36-53 contains 4 panes of stamps, all with watermark "e", upright or inverted:

- A. 1/2d O'Cleary, C22 in a pane of six, HP6/6wa
- B. 1d carmine map of Ireland, D17 in 2 panes of six, HP7/7wa
- C. 2½d red-brown arms of Ireland, D20 in a pane of six, HP11/11wa

(Here I show an exploded booklet I acquired for this purpose.)

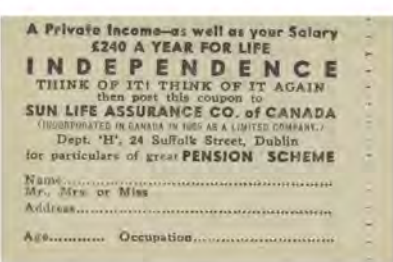

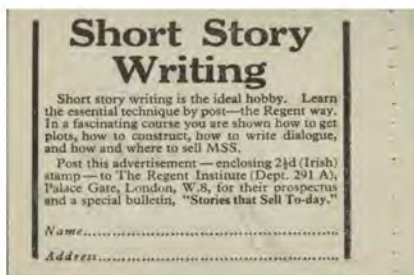

(Pages 2, 6, 10, & 14 are the reverse sides of the stamp panes, and are not shown to conserve space.)

When I compared my new 36-53 to the one I already had in my collection, I noticed one had an interleaf with postage rates between the last pane of stamps, HP6, and the back cover of the booklet; the other did not. Turning to the Hibernian bible, we find that Edition No. 36-53 is listed only in one variety, HB7a. But in front of me were two different interleaf configurations of edition 36-53. Many editions of HB7 exist, each identified by the year of issue, 31-48, 32-49, etc. HB7b and HB7c (both are very scarce compared to HB7a) and each has a unique variety. HB7b, Edition No. 31-48 does not include the last interleaf showing the postal rates.

HB7c, Edition 35-52 supplementary printing is without interleaving and with a blank inside front cover. Postal



rates are on the inside and outside of the back cover. I wrongly assumed that my newly acquired booklet was a complete HB7a. But if so, what was the other configuration I had just discovered that sat in my collection labelled HB7a?

Left & Right Images: The interleaf that matters are pages 15 and 16 of the recently purchased booklet, showing the inland and foreign postal rates. This interleaf is located between the last stamp pane, HP6, and the back cover of the booklet.



Who better to ask than the expert himself, Roy Hamilton-Bowen? I sent an email to Roy, with some images from the booklet. His response:

"Have now gone through my entire stock of 36-53 (which is quite substantial!) and not a single one of them has a Postal Rates interleaf between the ½d O'Cleary pane and the back cover.

So it looks like you have discovered something new which would indeed attract the cat. # HB 7d."

So, if you want to stop reading here and check out your HB7a or perhaps HB7d booklets, I will wait until you get back -----Any luck?

In June of this year while preparing to publish this article, I sent it to Phil Kane for critique. Phil directed me to a resource in The Irish Philatelic Circle's library, *Irish Booklets, A handbook of Irish Stamp Booklets, 1931 to 1991, By, C.I. Dulin FRPSL*. This is a comprehensive guide to Irish stamp Booklets, with 124 pages of in-depth information. Chapter 5 is devoted to Advertising: Covers & Interleaves. On page 87, Dulin describes the 1953 2/6 Code 36-53, suggesting that probably 500,000 were issued. More importantly to my discovery and excitement, Dulin also states; *"This booklet also exists in a no interleaf version [Hib# 7c] and probably is another reissue (although this has yet to be confirmed). It may also exist as a four-pane version, the extra interleaf carrying postal rate information."* Alas, C.I. Dulin in 1998 suggested the probability of the extra interleaf. Further study and investigation led me to The Revealer Vol. VIII, No. II, November - December 1957, where there is an article by Perry Adams, E.P.A. #84. He lists the advertisers, as shown above and a 4th interleaf of postal rates. Adams states, "There appear to have been at least three reissues of 36--53, varying in advertisers and the number of interleaves".

Now we know the booklet definitely exists and HB7d would be an appropriate catalogue number.

So, to clarify, the booklet I have had in my collection for years is indeed a HB7a. But, I have found a variety of Irish stamp booklet edition number 36-53 with 4 interleaves. The common configuration is 3 interleaves, one between each of the four panes of stamps. The new HB7d has an interleave with postal rates between the last pane HP6 and the back cover of the booklet. Does anyone else have a similar item? If so, please let all of us know, and also contact me so we can track how many might still exist.

I am grateful for the assistance given by Roy Hamilton-Bowen, without whom collecting Irish stamps would be impossible. My thanks to Liam Malone who helped create and edit this article. I am grateful to Phil Kane who set me straight.

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THE 1981 JAMES HOBAN JOINT ISSUE: 2021 THE YEAR OF FINDING THAT ILLUSIVE INFORMATION

Since autumn 2008 I have researched and published on the 1981 James Hoban stamp jointly issued by the USPS and the Irish Departments of Posts & Telegraphs. I have also exhibited, focusing on the cachets or the controversy behind the US stamp being issued in 18-cent and 20-cent denominations on the same day, October 13, 1981 in Washington, DC.

Judges asked me to find out if Postmaster Bolger actually said the stamp would be in use for a while, and when and how did the Reagans announce that they planned to use the stamp on their Christmas cards that year. In summer 2021 I found an online audio recording of the Dedication Ceremony in Washington, DC held on September 9, 1981, the day the Irish stamp was issued (<https://www.upi.com/Archives/1981/09/29/Nancy-Reagan-dedicated-a-stamp-without-a-price-Tuesday/4018370584000/>). The short ceremony featured Postmaster Bolger announcing that "...we want to make sure Americans will be able to use and see it for a long time...." This is exactly what I needed. His words foretold how the Hoban stamp found so many uses long after its issuance. As First Lady, Nancy Reagan, was the real force behind the stamp being issued in the first place. At the Ceremony she said: "I am pleased to be able to announce that we will use the Hoban stamp as postage on the White House Christmas cards this year." This announcement is precisely what I had been searching for.

An event I wish I could have attended occurred on March 16, 2021 when The Historical Association paid tribute to Hoban at his gravesite in Mount Olivet Cemetery near the Catholic University of America. The Irish ambassador, a member of the clergy, and leader from the distinguished Daughters of the American Revolution remarked on Hoban's life and influence. They also all committed to restoring the marker and keeping up the gravesite.

2021 was also the publication of a heavily illustrated book by the White House Historical Association. I read the coffee-table style book in an afternoon. I learned a good deal about Hoban's milieu and about the Federal District and the actual structure. I was disappointed because the book barely mentions the stamps. The only stamp image is a single Fleetwood FDC White House cachet with the Irish stamp.

Announcing 1755 as the Year of Hoban's Birth and Baptism

James Hoban was born in Cuffesgrange district of Desart, County Kilkenny, Ireland in 1762. Hoban died in Washington, DC on December 8, 1831. These two short sentences summarizing the length of Hoban's life are typical sentences found in published articles, notices, and similar writings about James Hoban. But the discovery in 2016 of Hoban's baptismal record, changed his birth year to 1755.

I announce it on the cover in Figure 2. Would a better arrangement allow for a single cancellation strike? The Immigration stamp fits nicely here.

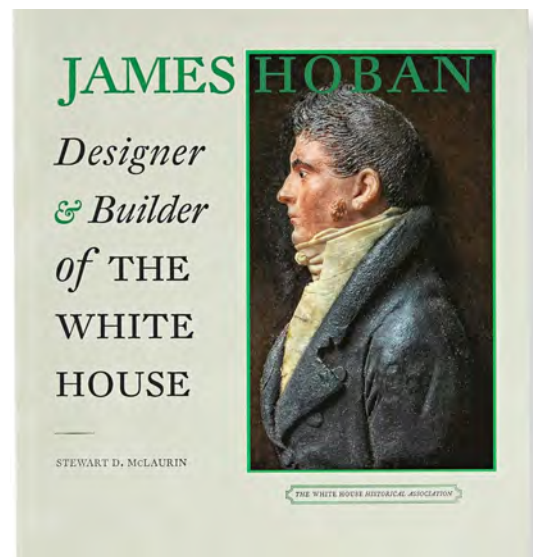


Figure 1: From <https://shop.whitehousehistory.org>

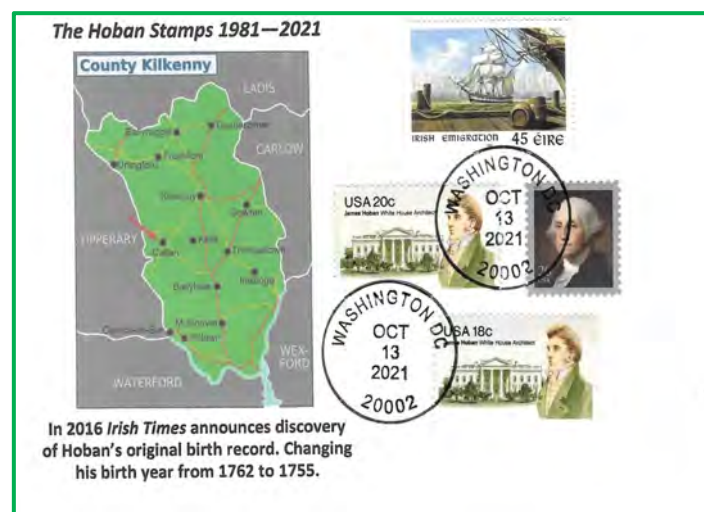


Figure 2: Cover indicating correct year of Hoban's baptism

Ten million historic Irish Catholic records dating from the Cromwellian era to the First World War, including baptismal, marriage and death records, will be available online free of charge throughout March.... Also included is James Hoban who designed the White House in Washington. He was baptised at Callan, County

Kilkenny, on April 18th, 1755. Before now the year of his birth was a cause for speculation as a consequence of his obituary. But 1755 has finally been established because of the discovery of the original baptismal record.

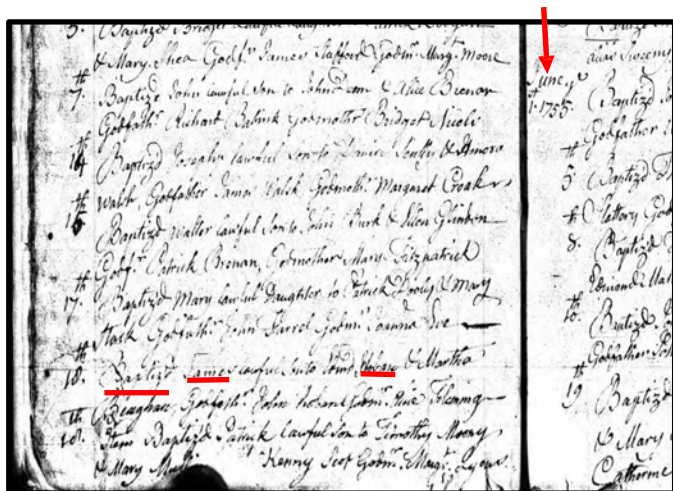


Figure 3: Baptismal record

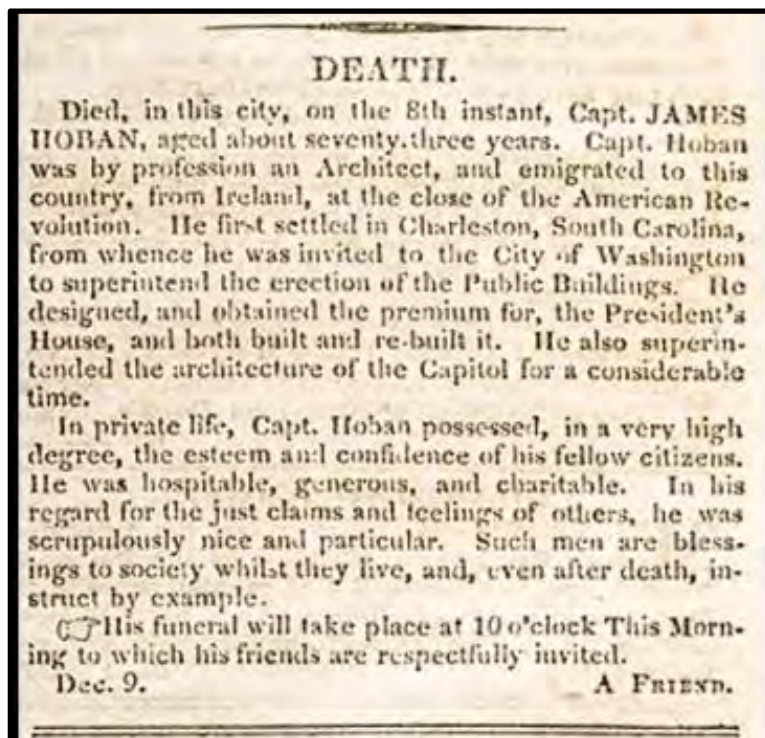


Figure 4: National Intelligencer (Washington, D.C.)

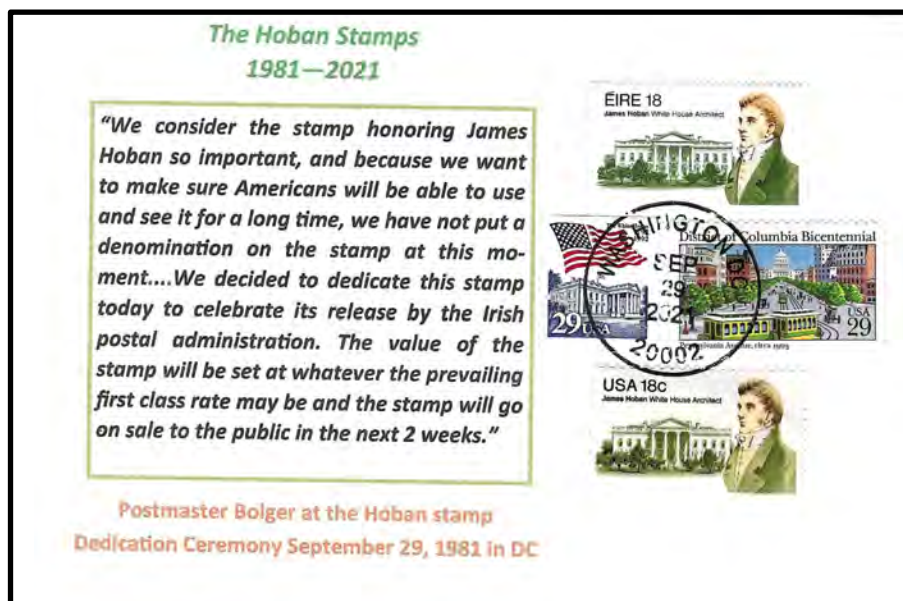

40th Anniversary Event Covers

Postmaster General Bolger was a second generation Irish-American. He said We (meaning the USPS) also take enormous pride in our postage stamps. Because millions of people see and use and even save postage stamps. So, 165,000,000 stamps bearing James Hoban will be printed. He mentioned the first class rate change when he said: "governors of the postal service will meet this afternoon to consider this matter and the result may be a change in postage rate."

During the Dedication Ceremony he also announced that another reason the stamps were issue was "...to give James Hoban the wide recognition that has been long overdue."



This cover quotes Bolger at the Ceremony. I used a 1992 regular Flag stamp because when issued many cover artists incorporated the Hoban stamp. I selected the Irish and US 18-cent stamp to reflect the original, what everyone thought the first-class rate would be. I added the 29-cent Bicentennial of the District of Columbia in 1991. I thought that if I place the stamps close together, a single cancel would strike all four stamps.

When creating covers you decide about an insert. It can make the cover more attractive and educational. And, it also adds a little stiffener which helps when being cancelled.

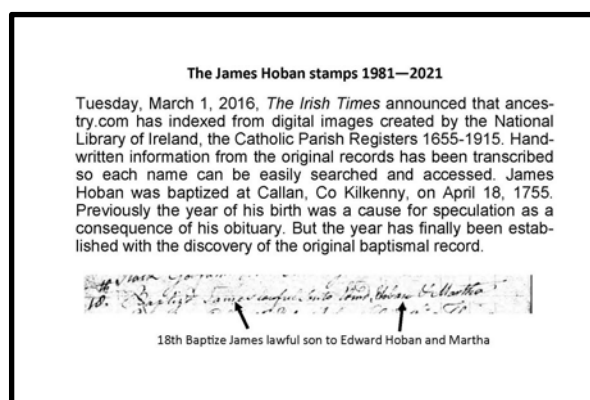


Figure 7: Pamphlet

I created the above cover for the anniversary of the Dedication Ceremony and first day of issue for the Irish Stamp. I selected the Reagan stamp because the colors look like the colors of the Hoban stamp. Above right, is a cachet of the Christmas card cancelled on the DFI of the Nancy Reagan stamp. To the right is an image of the envelope with the same 20-cent stamp showing typical foxing. Notice the simple return address. The destination, Fairfax, VA, is close to where I live in DC.

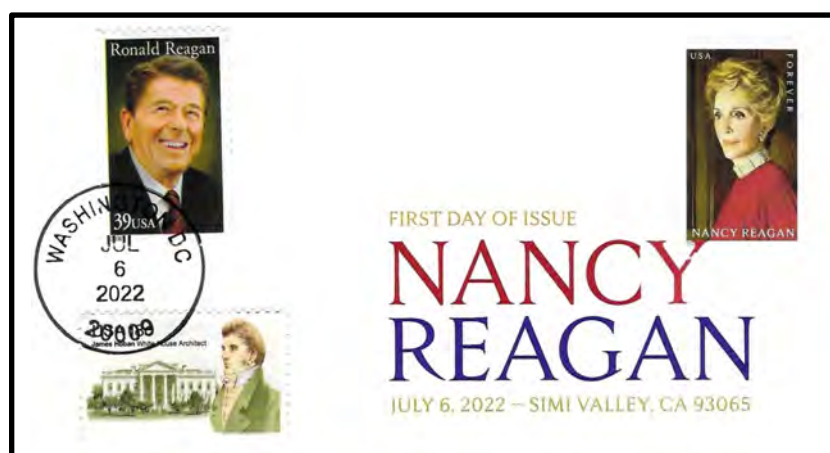


Figure 11: The Nancy Reagan FDC

The USPS recently used digitized, color postmarks that cost a little more than standard postmarked FDCs. Is my using the Hoban stamp part of Bolger's remarks that the Hoban stamp will be used for a long time? I had to use a Washington, DC cancellation.

On March 16, 2021, C-Span taped the ceremony at Hoban's gravesite when the White House Historical Assoc. and the Daughters of the American Revolution committed to preserving and caring for Hoban's grave.

LETTER TO THE REVEALER'S READERS

GEORGE FABIAN (GFABIAN2@SBCGLOBAL.NET) ASKS:

In collecting Irish covers, I run across covers that I cannot explain the postage used. Maybe some reader can help.

The illustrated cover is from the Aug. 26, 1932 First Air Mail from Galway to London. The cover was then forwarded to Paris, France. The postal rate to France was 3d. There was to be no air mail surcharge for the air mail from Galway to London.

Why was the 2d stamp added?

Below is a cover on the same Irish First Air Mail flight from Galway to London and then flown by Luft Hansa from London to Berlin but the postage can be explained. The postage of 9¢ can be explained as follows:



The United States postage rate to Germany was 5¢.

The air mail from Galway to London was free of charge as the Experimental flight was paid for by Irish Airways Ltd.

For the air mail from London to Berlin, the U.S. Onward Air Transmission fee of 4¢ was charged.

Another question: Over the years I have probably seen a dozen covers from Dublin, Ireland to Brazil via the Graf Zeppelin. All had 12½d postage with an extra 3d if it was Registered. *How much of the 12½d went to the Graf Zeppelin Company?*

CIE BUS PARCEL STAMPS

Like their railway counterparts, bus stamps have no postal franking value. They do, however, show that fees have been paid to move the mail by the national bus transport system. Córas Iompair Éireann (Irish for 'Irish Transport System'), which is a statutory corporation of Ireland, answerable to the Irish Government and responsible for most public transport within the Republic of Ireland. Its officers are appointed by the Minister for Transport.

CIÉ is the holding company for Bus Éireann, Dublin Bus and Iarnród Éireann/Irish Rail, the three largest internal transport companies in Ireland. It also manages CIE Tours.

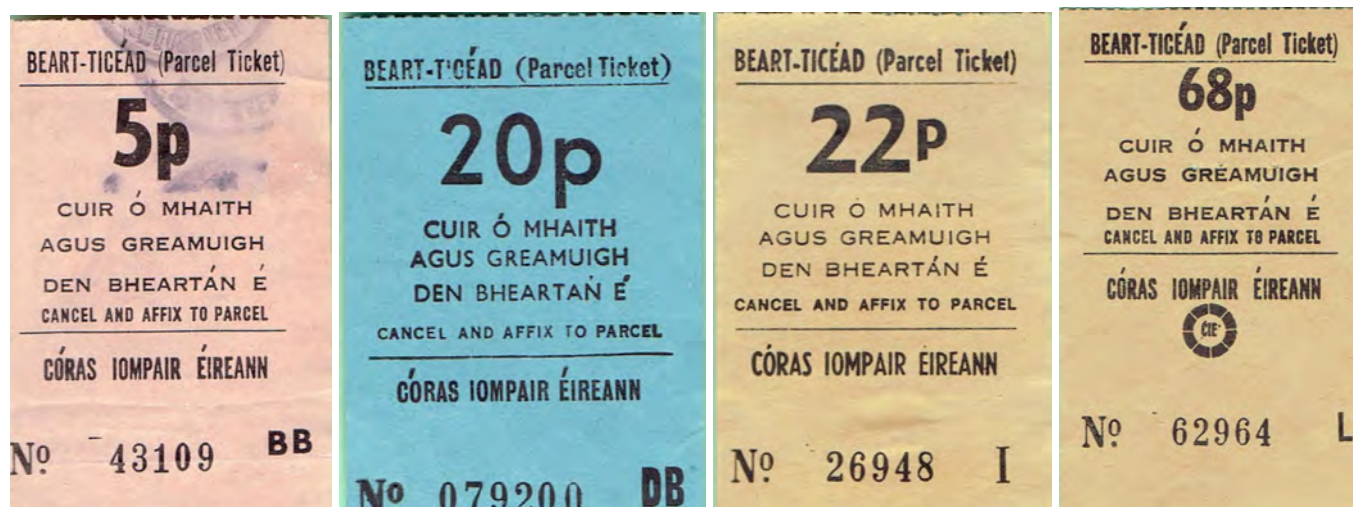
CIE was established in 1945 to take over private railways which had deteriorated due to lack of investment, reduced maintenance, and lack of modern equipment. It led the way in getting modern highways and motorways built to aid in inter-connectability, and, today, link the scenic winding roads to modern connectors and motorways.

As rail links reduced, buses filled more of the role of moving letters and small packages, but the service is separate from the postal functions, which must be paid separately, thus the 6d stamp on figure 1 pays the postal rate for inland Ireland and Great Britain. Since the bus and train schedules are linked, it resulted in faster service, but not quite express service, but a lower cost.

The cover in Figure 1 above was printed in the Pound/Shilling/Penny time (before 1 January 1971, when Ireland converted to the decimal pound system). The rate increased in increments up to €7.50 by 1999 and is reflected in the stamps after 1970, Figures 2-5. Other values are known. Unfortunately, like most items and services, inflation has made its mark.

The stamps could be purchased at bus termini, but unlike the railway letter stamps were subject to a small surcharge if purchased from the bus conductor at an on-route stop. These stamps are not listed in a catalog, but most likely have been replaced by computer-generated receipts. If a reader is aware of a catalog or a rate sheet, their input would be appreciated.

Life on a country estate in the middle of Ireland was tranquil, peaceful, and away from the “Hustle - Bustle” of Dublin. Maybe not everyone’s dream, since the isolation may be too much. To make it easier for the customer, some brilliant lad working for the Midland Great Western Railway (MGWRy), which covered the sector to the west and northwest of Dublin to the Atlantic Coast developed the concept of carrying shippers’ market-baskets to customers at less-than-carload freight rate. A market basket was a lockable container with a rod and padlock and came in several different sizes. It would be shipped empty to a predetermined merchant from the nearest MGWR station by using a prepaid stamp, along with a shopping list and a return stamp. The merchant had a key to the lock, and would fill the order, apply the new stamp, lock it, and return it for the MGWR to convey it to the nearest station to the customer, for local delivery.

Stamps to pay for movement of the empty container normally had red or black diagonal lines while those for movement of a full container did not. These were not dinky little stamps, like postage stamps, but sized for their importance and value.

As with most other things, the rate and conditions changed with time. Several different series of stamps were used to reflect changes in conditions and rates. Note the 6d stamp and the 9d stamp below. The earlier green one was 6d for less than 7 pounds weight and included local transfer. The newer 9d stamp (white) was still limited to less than seven pounds BUT the local transfer is not included! A similar case is seen on the purple 9d and the white 1 shilling 2 penny stamp.

The stamps were often sold in booklets of 13 at a discounted “baker’s dozen” price (13 for the price of 12).

The result was to make the customer (and hopefully, his wife) happy since they avoided a trip; the merchant was happy since he made a sale; and the MGWR happy since it increased their freight revenues.

FIRST DAY COVER PROJECT – UPDATE

AN IRISH AIR MAIL ENVELOPE USED FOR A CANADIAN FIRST FLIGHT

A short time back I was able to persuade a member of our philatelic library here in San Diego to give me a cover he was looking at to purchase for perhaps less than one dollar.

The reason I was interested in this particular envelope is it was an example of an early Irish Air-Mail etiquette envelope. To me, more interesting, is that the printed address on this envelope was from Charles F. Bourke, an early Irish dealer, originally working out of Waterford, Ireland. The Revealer has a number of articles regarding Bourke, mostly dealing with Irish FDC, and St. Patrick Day covers from Ireland, particularly from the 1930s to the early 1950s.

The first thing that one would notice about this cover is it is an example of the numerous first flight covers regarding the opening of Canada in the 1920s and 30s, to air mail delivery; this particular example sent from Calgary, January 15, 1931. The stamp used for this flight is the first issue from Canada for air-mail delivery.



The colored stripes of green, the white part of the envelope, and a faded looking yellow and/or orange perhaps tried to mirror the Irish flag. The Irish, AER-PHOST, is definitely translated to AIR-Mail



The back of this cover has the same-colored stripes across the back with the English Air Mail printed. The post mark of Lethbridge, Alberta shows the destination of this early flight cover. More interesting from an Irish perspective is the label, Spring Show, Ballsbridge, Dublin, May 7,8,9,10, 1930, The country's Barometer. Most of the covers in my collection that have labels seem to be following postal regulations that require such labels to be affixed to the back of the envelope.

If something looks a little odd or out of place, it might prove rewarding looking a little further into the matter.
